WITNESS STATEMENT OF MARK LAURENCE SHELDON

- I, Mark Laurence Sheldon, structural engineer, of 850 Collins Street, Melbourne Victoria, make the following statement in the abovementioned proceedings:
- I am a structural engineer and Technical Director at Aurecon Australasia which conducts business at 850 Collins Street, Melbourne Victoria.
- 2. I have the qualifications and experience set out in a document attached to this witness statement (Attachment 1). In summary I have substantial experience and expertise in the field of structural engineering. I have also led numerous multidiscipline projects. I have a sound understanding of how buildings are constructed. I have also led many remedial engineering, projects involving condition assessments and refurbishment projects.
- 3. I have been assisted in the formatting and presentation of this witness statement by Nick Sutton of Planning and Property Partners Pty Ltd. I adopt the content of this statement as my evidence before the Heritage Council. The views expressed in this witness statement are my own.
- This witness statement has been prepared in response to written instructions provided to me by Planning and Property Partners Pty Ltd which are attached (Attachment 2)
- 5. In general terms I am instructed to:
 - Review the material supplied to me in relation to the Heritage Council Registration Hearing concerning former Oriental Hotel;
 - Review the expert evidence I previously prepared in respect of the former Oriental in VCAT proceeding P625/2013;
 - Consider and formulate my own opinions with respect to the following matters, within the limits of my expertise:

- whether any relevant facts have changed since I formulated my previous expert evidence in respect of the Former Oriental Hotel that affect my earlier opinion(s).
- whether the expert opinion(s) previously expressed by me concerning the Former Oriental Hotel remain unchanged, or otherwise.
- Prepare a witness statement which sets out the conclusions I have reached
 and clearly states the basis or assumption which I have made which form
 part of the reasoning by which I reach my conclusions. My witness
 statement should enclose my earlier evidence concerning the former Oriental
 Hotel.

Previous Involvement

6. I have previous experience with the former Oriental Hotel. In 2013, following a series of inspections, I prepared an expert witness statement dated 7 June 2013. My statement of evidence in relation to the former Oriental Hotel is provided as Attachment 3 of this statement.

Opinions

- As noted above, I prepared an expert witness statement dated 7 June 2013. In June 2013, I also:
 - Gave evidence to the Tribunal that was consistent with my written statement of evidence.
 - b. In the course of giving evidence, presented a series of drawings showing the results of a data cloud survey of the walls as colour contours on each face of the building. This shows, in summary, the curvature of each wall. A copy of these drawings is provided as Attachment 4 of this statement.
- 8. My opinions on the condition of the building at the time I gave evidence to the Tribunal in June 2013 can be summarised as follows:
 - a. The structure was not safe to enter.
 - b. The south east corner of the building is beyond repair and needs to be demolished.
 - c. The extent of the movements in the external walls is severe. Regardless of any rectification techniques employed, it will not be possible to return the walls to plumb position.

- d. In addition to the south east corner, there is a real risk that the walls or parts of the walls will collapse or are not possible to repair, and would have to be completely or partially removed and reinstated.
- 9. Since giving evidence to VCAT in relation to the Former Oriental Hotel in 2013 I have, as part of responding to the instructions given to me in this case, considered:
 - The application to nominate the Former Oriental Hotel for inclusion in the Victorian Heritage Register;
 - b. The recommendation of the Executive Director to the Heritage Council; and
 - c. All submissions to the recommendation of the Executive Director.
- 10. I note that nothing in any of the material which I have considered in response to my instructions in this matter in any way causes me to alter my opinion in relation to the condition of the building.

Declaration

11. I declare that I have made all the inquiries that I believe are desirable and appropriate and that no matters of significance which I regard as relevant have to my knowledge been withheld from the Heritage Council of Victoria.
